

# CHRISTMAS CHORUS

1. Order extra copies of music
2. Make up music folders for members and guests (matching so they can be used when you perform. Guests are not expected to memorize the music)..
3. Print fliers to hand out - 10 to every Chapter member
4. First meeting -
  - Voice placement to section
  - Regular chorus warm-up
  - Sing some Pole Cat songs
5. Make them feel welcome. "Big Brothers" to help hold the music..
6. Sing all Christmas Carols during 1st half of meeting. Last half of meeting is normal Chorus rehearsal of regular Chorus repertoire. (They are welcome to stay if they wish)..
7. DO NOT have your Chorus sing for guests on first night. Don't try to impress them with how good you are.. They'll find out sooner or later.
8. Place guests in Chorus along side the more accurate voices.
9. Decide uniform for caroling
  - (something members & guests would already have)
  - Dark trousers
  - White shirt and tie
10. Add names to Show ticket mailing list
11. Add names to Chapter Bulletin mailing
12. No long term commitment. If they like what they hear they'll come back..
