

“State of the Chapter”

Good Chapter organization is the product of a **Leadership Team** that knows it’s chapter well enough to identify its current deficiencies and to establish a set of goals it believes it can accomplish.

Insure the following are in order:

1. Expectations of the Chapter are defined
2. Measurable goals established
3. Goals are achievable
4. Mission of the Chapter is defined

Determine “State of the Chapter”

1. Vision - Mission - (what do the members want)
2. Priorities - goals - objectives
3. Chapter strengths - list
4. Chapter weaknesses - identify needs

Recognize that **Music** is our Product -

1. Improve music - our membership will improve
2. Concentrate on good singing - performances will improve
3. Minimize the visibility of administration at meetings
4. Guests are impressed by good singing - not by administration

Are the following area’s in place:

1. Chapters Leadership Team established for the year.
2. Chapter Budget is developed with input from officers & committees.
3. Goals and objectives are established by the following:
 Music Team
 Membership Team
4. Assess the Chapters progress throughout the year.
5. Provide communication to the membership - weekly/monthly
6. Committee assignments - get others involved
